Reduce. Re-use. Recycle.' worksheet. This is an activity for four groups of students.</p> <p>Consider: Once the plan has been made, will you actually have the party?</p> <p>Activity: Each group is designated the task to plan one of the following: Decoration, Entertainment, Food or Clean-up. While planning what they will use/do, the sustainable practices: Avoid, Reduce, Re-use, and Recycle must be put in place.</p>
