Here are some situations where people have to choose to do the right thing.

Use them to practise Integrity.

* You witness a classmate being bullied in the toilets at school...

* You told your friend that you would meet them at the park but you're really enjoying playing on your X-Box...

* You're playing football with your friend and you accidentally break the neighbours window...

* You find the last piece of chocolate cake in the fridge, but you know that your sister is hoping to have it for dessert later...

* You see your best friend steal some money from the teacher's desk...

INTEGRITY - DO THE RIGHT THING

VALUE TOPIC: Integrity - the quality of being honest and having strong moral principles that you refuse to change.

CATCH PHRASE: Do the right thing.
Mahia te mahi tika (Do the right thing).

Problem: I keep losing friends because of my dishonest behaviour.

Scene It! - Integrity

Thinking of examples and scenarios on the spot can be tricky, so here are a few to get the thinking started. Some of the scenarios may have already been seen in other parts of this Value Topic, however there is no harm in using them again. As suggested in the Value Topic Plan, you can present these scenarios in a variety of ways: **act** the scenario out; **write** about the given scenario; **draw** a comic strip; or have **discussion** in groups. Whichever medium is chosen students will need to come up with a solution **modelling** the specific Value Topic - Integrity.

In addition:

- Allow students to also demonstrate how the scenario would pan out if the value topic wasn't utilised in each scenario.
- Give students opportunity to 'debrief' and give feedback on each other's presentations.
