Show Us Your Integrity

Imagine yourself in these situations and explain what could be done that shows integrity.

You see your best friend steal some money from the teacher's desk.

You find the last piece of chocolate cake in the fridge, but you know that your sister is hoping to have it for dessert later.

You jokingly said something about somebody else in your class at morning tea time, later on you hear the same thing being repeated as a rumour.

You witness a classmate being bullied in the toilets at school.

VALUE TOPIC: Integrity - the quality of being honest and having strong moral principles that you refuse to change.

CATCH PHRASE: Do the right thing. Mahia te mahi tika (Do the right thing).
